 - Made your name great(**1 Pet. 4:15-16**).
 - 3. Appoint for you a place(**John 14:1-3**).
 - Build you a house.
 - Kingdom established forever(**Heb. 12:28**).
- B. GOD'S PROMISE GIVES US COURAGE TO SEEK FORGIVENESS
(**1 John 1:6-7, 9; 2:1-2**).
- C. WE NEED TO SEE OUR GUILT, SHAME, UNWORTHINESS.
 - 1. Need to accept responsibility, to feel guilt and shame.
 - 2. Shame is the feeling that arises from acknowledging guilt.

 - b. Shame is not to be gloried in(**Phil. 3:19**).
